The Female Persuasion by Meg Wolitzer Fiction

In this almost prescient novel about the women's movement, a college student's life is changed after a chance meeting with a feminist icon.

Alternate Side by Anna Quindlen Fiction

Anna Quindlen captures the angst and anxiety of modern life with a story set in an upper-class Manhattan neighborhood that turns on an incident of parking rage.

The Sand Castle Girls by Chris Bohjalian Fiction

The Armenian genocide during WW 1 is the subject. Inspired by his grandparents, the author explores the suffering and atrocities of that time.

Text Me When You Get Home: The Evolution and Triumph of Modern Female Relationships by Kayleen Schaefer Fiction

A celebration of female friendships that rejects the popular notion that women's relationships with each other are fundamentally flawed.

The Warmth of Other Suns by Isabel Wilkerson Non-fiction

This work tells the story of the Great Migration and the Second Great Migration, the movement of African Americans out of the Southern US to the Midwest, Northeast and West from approximately 1915-1970

The House at Sugar Beach by Helene Cooper Autobiography

The life of Helene Cooper's early years growing up in Liberia

Varina by Charles Frasier Historical Fiction

The author of Cold Mountain returns to the Civil War with a story about Varina Howell Davis, the wife of the president of the Confederate States of America

The Housekeeper and the Professor by Yoko Ogawa Fiction

Originally written in Japanese, this is a story about a prominent math professor whose short term memory only lasts 80 minutes. A new housekeeper and her 10 year old son come into his life, creating a virtual family.

Luncheon of the Boating Party by Susan Vreeland Historical Fiction

The author uses art history and Renoir's painting as the basis for a carefully constructed historical novel.
